Spring To-do List

Check for leaks in pipes, around toilets and dripping faucets.

Test smoke and carbon monoxide detectors and replace batteries.

Look for signs of pests.

Air conditioning: Check around the unit for indications of leaks. Before turning it on for the season, have your air conditioning system inspected and tuned up by a professional. Check the drain lines annually and clean them if they are clogged. Change the air filter.

Appliances: Check supply lines for ice makers and water dispensers, refrigerators, and dishwashers for signs of leaks or wear and tear.

Personal Items not Sparking Joy?

Take appropriate means to properly dispose of used items. Try recycling or donate. All trash must fit INSIDE dumpster and cannot be left outside.
